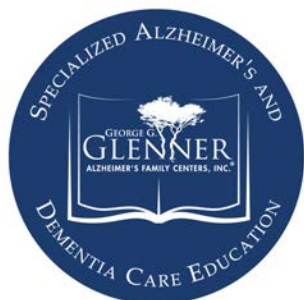


The Glenner GRACE™ Model for Dementia Care
