

GLENNERCARE™ is:

- A virtual service that provides dementia care support via phone, email &/or video call.
- Designed to reduce unnecessary visits to the doctor, urgent care center, emergency room &/or hospital.
- This service is included at no additional cost with enrollment at any of the Glenner Day Centers.
- The GLENNERCARE™ model is now growing nationally through a private, for-profit company called VirtuALZ. The Glenner Centers have assigned VirtuALZ the GLENNERCARE™ intellectual property enabling them to expand our original model across the country.

A Memory Café is a safe, supportive environment, often described as a "meet up", designed to engage attendees in cognitive activities. The goal of the Glenner Centers' Memory Cafés is to keep attendees mentally and socially active which research shows is protective of brain health. These gatherings are offered free to the public.

The Glenner Centers' Memory Café Program resumed in September 2022 in Solana Beach, CA. We look forward to opening additional sites in the future.
