Little Blue House Model The Original Glenner Center



Our Hillcrest Center, affectionately known as the "Little Blue House", was the first Glenner Center, founded in 1982 by Dr. George G. Glenner and his wife, Joy Glenner.

Licensed for 24 participants, this specialized adult day center operates within a true residential home. The smaller setting creates a warm, familiar environment where participants feel comfortable, safe and at home.

Assisted Living Community Model



The Assisted Living Community (ALC) Model creates a Glenner Center within an existing residential community that has approximately 2,500 square feet of available space.

Under this partnership model, Glenner Centers operate and manage a dedicated adult day program within the assisted living community, creating a seamless continuum of care. Families who aren't quite ready for residential placement can start with adult day care, making the transition to assisted living smooth and familiar as needs progress.

Town Square® Model



Town Square® is the Glenner Centers' newest adult day center located in Chula Vista, CA. Town Square® is the first immersive Reminiscence Therapy Day Center for individuals with dementia in the world.

The center has been designed to replicate a 1950s/1960s town to bring its participants back to a time where their memories are their strongest.

The Town Square® model inspired the development of a national franchise system.
